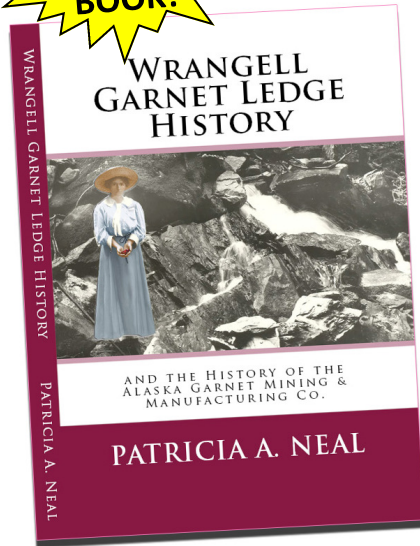




NEW BOOK ON WRANGELL'S HISTORY!



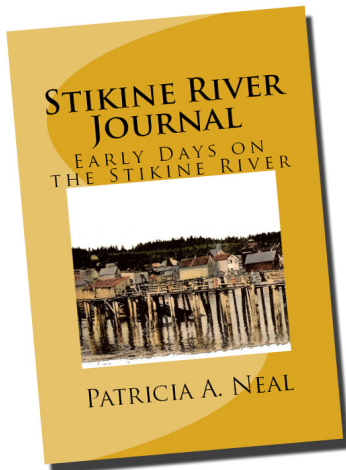
Wrangell Garnet Ledge History and the Alaska Garnet Mining & Manufacturing Co. Authored by Patricia A Neal

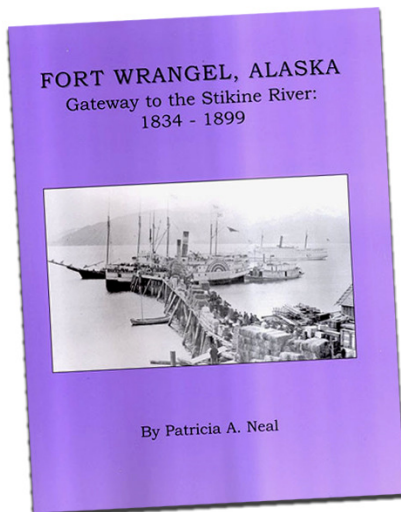
