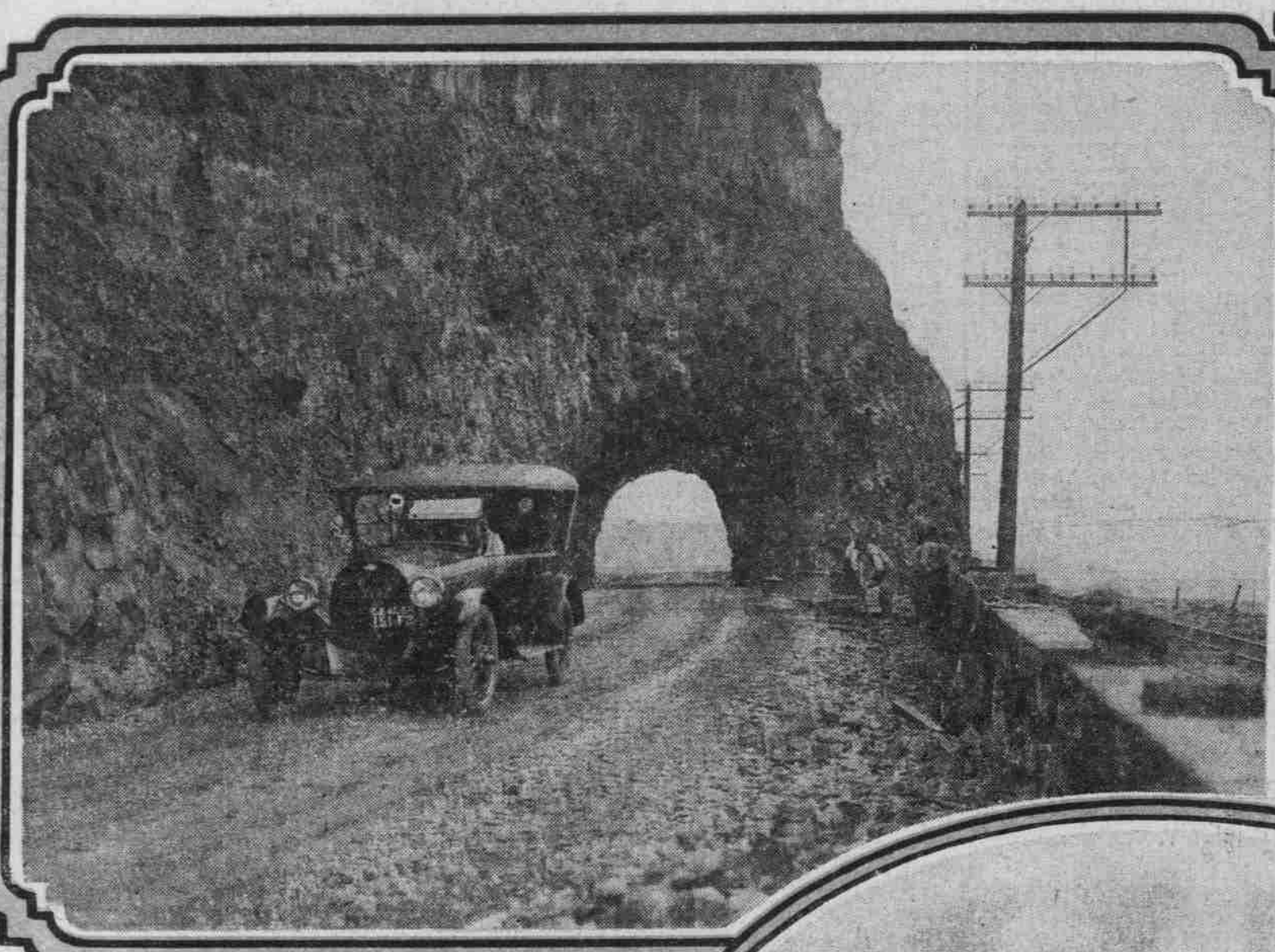
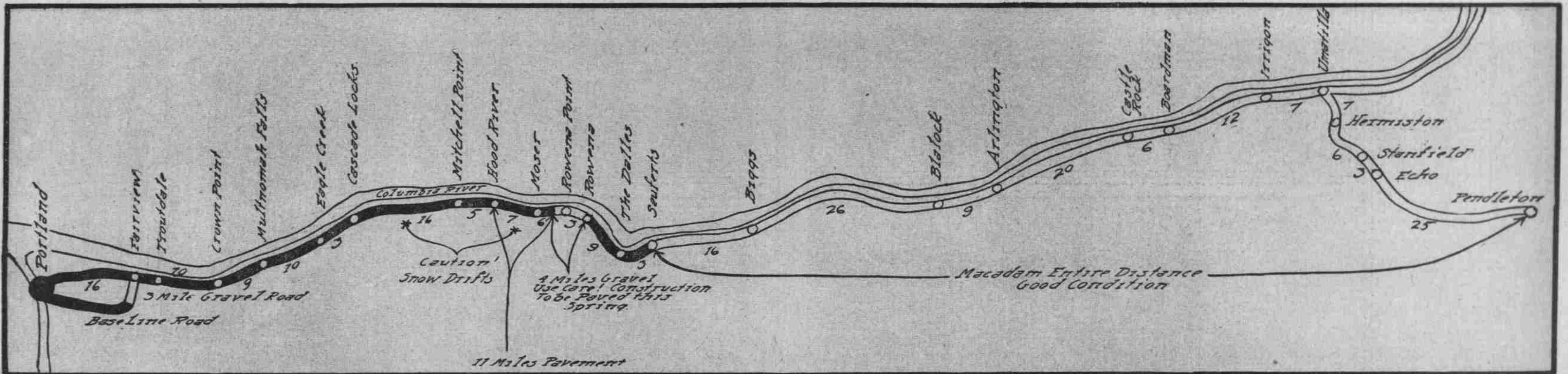


Columbia Highway Again in Good Shape Chevrolet Motorist Finds



Highway's Newest Tunnel, - East of Celilo.

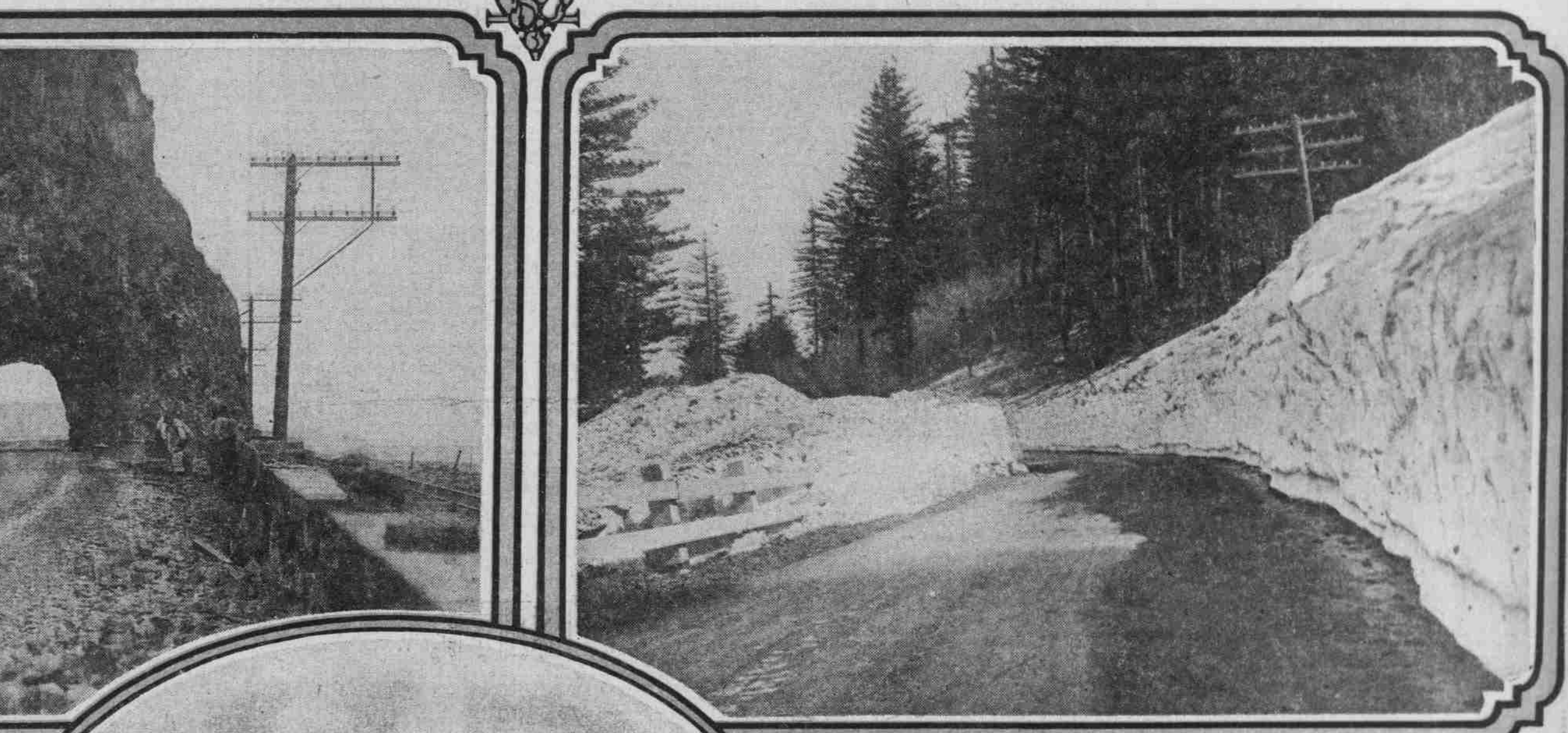
BY H. W. LYMAN. AFTER having gone through a winter of unusual experiences, the Columbia river highway has passed the test and is again back in good condition...

LANE OFFICIALS INVESTIGATE PACIFIC RIGHT-OF-WAY. Junction City-Harrisburg Route Is Being Studied; Some Favor Highway Via Coburg.

EUGENE, Or., April 1.—(Special.)—With a view to the probable construction of the Pacific highway the entire distance between Junction City and the Willamette river opposite Harrisburg this year, the state highway commission at its recent meeting in Portland proposed to the Lane county court that if the county will obtain the right-of-way and do the grading, the state will surface the roadway with macadam.
