

AIRPLANE SQUADRON WELCOMED IN ALASKA

WRANGELL, Alaska — The army airplane expedition en route from Minneola, New York, to Nome, Alaska, reached here late on Saturday from Hazelton, British Columbia. The landing on Sergiel Island, near here, was witnessed by the entire population of Wrangell. Capt. St. Clair Street said the flight from Hazelton to Wrangell was over an almost continuous chain of glaciers, and had proved by far the most interesting part of the trip.

The expedition was to leave here for White Horse, Yukon Territory, a distance of 300 miles.
